Calculators

If your child has chosen to study a Senior Years Mathematics course in 2019 the Mathematics Learning Area advises that all senior students are required to have and use a **graphics calculator** in their Mathematics lessons.

Mobile phones or smart watches are not appropriate for this purpose as they do not offer all the functions which are needed for Problem solving in Mathematics. It is also the policy of the School that mobile phones are not seen or used in class. Mobile phones or smart watches are also not approved to be used in SACE Board authorised assessments.

The SACE Board has specifications and conditions for use of graphics and scientific calculators in external examinations. Frequent and appropriate use of graphics calculators throughout the year is recommended to ensure satisfactory use during examinations. While the SACE Board recognises a number of graphics calculators, **The Heights Mathematics Learning Area recommends the CASIO FX-CG50au**. This is the calculator teachers will use in class.

The **CASIO FX-CG50au** is available for purchase from the recognised retailers like Officeworks for approximately \$240.
