- Acceleration based on our understanding of the individual and only in a limited selection of subjects. (End Yr 9 only. Small number of students.)





The Application Process

Students are selected for entry to the IGNITE program through an ACER (Australian Council for Education Research) assessment which is held in February. Each year The Heights School accepts up to 60 students through this process.

The assessment is open to students who are in **Year 6 at the time of testing**, **for entry into Year 7 the following year**. The test can only be taken once and only at one of the three schools.

Students that have been selected into the IGNITE program are guaranteed direct entry into The Heights School, regardless of whether they live in zone*.

* limited to 40 places





The Application Process

The ACER assessment comprises four parts, completed over a period of 5 hours with time allowed for a break.

- Reading Comprehension (45 min)
- Mathematical Reasoning (40 min)
- BREAK
- Abstract Reasoning (30 min)
- Written Expression (25 min)

Test: Saturday Feb 21st, 2026

Registration 8:15am - 8:30am

Students met by parents: 12.50-1.20pm

Cost: \$150 (for non-school card holders)

Results

- All tests are sent to ACER in Melbourne to be marked. We anticipate results within 9-10 weeks.
- Offers are made early to mid Term 2 (possibility of two rounds of offers)
- If an offer is not made, students may be offered a place on the waiting list.





The Application Process

Registration for the test

- Register for the test at ONLY ONE SCHOOL.
- Register at the school that you wish to attend.
- Registration opens on Monday November 4th and closes on Wednesday 11th February

Preparation for the test

 Once you register, a letter will be sent from the testing school with further information about the testing day and some sample questions.

Ignite | The Heights School





- Refund request prior to close of registration date incurs \$25 fee (\$125 reimbursed to candidate)
- Refund request after close of registration date (but before test) incurs \$50 fee (\$100 reimbursed to candidate)
- No refunds after test date

School card holders

- Register all details in the system and save registration prior to the payment page.
- Contact the school to check eligibility
- The school will process registrations through to completion without the parent having to make payment.
